

North Florida Music Camp Rules and Regulations

1. Students are expected to attend ALL scheduled classes, rehearsals and concerts. Attendance will be taken. You must notify a camp counselor if you are too sick to attend class. Habitual tardiness or missed classes will result in being asked to leave camp.
2. No student will be allowed to operate a motor vehicle during the course of the camp.
3. While in the dorm, students are under the supervision of the counseling staff and are expected to abide by their decisions. Rudeness and disrespect will not be tolerated.
4. The use of alcoholic beverages, narcotics, or tobacco is strictly prohibited. The use or possession is cause for immediate dismissal. Parents will be called to pick up offending students.
5. Students will not be allowed to leave campus at any time during the camp. Exceptions will be made for day campers wishing to leave with their parents for a meal.
6. Students are expected to be in their rooms by curfew time and abide by lights-out rules set by the Camp Director and counselors.
7. Dorm furniture is not to be moved.
8. The dorm elevator is off limits. Only handicapped students or campers with a doctor's written explanation of a physical problem will be allowed to use the elevator.
9. Cell phones should not be used during classes or concerts. Better yet, leave your cell phone in your dorm during the day. Violators will have their phones confiscated for the remainder of the day.

MEALS

Campers will be issued a nametag when they register. You must wear this tag at all times. It is also used as a meal card - you must wear it in order to enter the cafeteria. No refunds will be issued to campers who do not use all of their allotted meals. If you are not going to eat, please do not go through the line at the cafeteria.

AUTO REGULATIONS

Camp members may NOT operate automobiles while attending the Camp. If personally driven autos are essential in order to provide transportation to and from the camp, these vehicles MUST be registered with the camp office, parked in the designated area with an official UNF parking permit (furnished by the camp office when the auto is registered.)

THE CAMP WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PARKING TICKETS RECEIVED IF AUTOS ARE NOT PARKED IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS AS SHOWN ON THE PARKING PERMITS.

Parents attending the Thursday, June 21 concert must purchase parking pass for their vehicle. Failure to do so will result in a parking ticket.

SECURITY

There are small lockers available in the Music Building for small instruments, such as flutes and clarinets. All larger instruments will be stored in the band equipment room or kept in the dorm rooms.

BE SURE YOU HAVE YOUR INSTRUMENTS LABELED WITH YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS. Resident campers will each have a key to their own dorm room, and rooms MUST be kept locked at all times. IF YOU WISH TO USE A DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC LOCKER, YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN LOCK. NEVER LEAVE YOUR INSTRUMENT OR OTHER PERSONAL BELONGS UNATTENDED. WE CANNOT BE RESPONSIBLE IF PERSONAL ITEMS ARE STOLEN OR LOST DUE TO NEGLIGENCE. UNF DOES NOT HAVE INSURANCE TO COVER STOLEN INSTRUMENTS.
