Elective Descriptions:

Combo -- A combo is a small jazz group consisting of rhythm section (piano or guitar, bass and drums), and one to four horns. Vocalists are also eligible for combo. Students must audition for combo.

Conducting -- Learn basic conducting patterns, score reading and rehearsal techniques. Students will be able to practice what they learn within the classroom. Knowledge of basic conducting will enhance your ensemble skills.

Drum line -- Spend time as a group and one on one learning proper drum line technique and musicality. The directors and technicians on the UNF Drum line will give instruction and demonstration and students will have the opportunity to perform with them as well.

Giants of Jazz – Listen to historic recordings and videotapes of the Jazz Masters from Louis Armstrong to Wynton Marsalis.

Music Masters – The important musical works of western civilization are brought to life via historic recordings and videotapes from Bach to Bernstein.
